

- **Meeting of agency** representatives with jurisdiction as it relates to the emergency.
- **Merging of incident** management structures.









- Single incident organization
- **Co-located (shared) facility**
- One Incident Action Plan
- Integrated general staff
- Coordinated process for resource ordering





- Jurisdictions/agencies blend into an integrated, unified team.
- Members must function together for this to be effective.





### Co-located/Shared Facilities

- Incident commanders need to be together.
- The rest of the organization must function together in a single incident command post so coordination/ collaboration can be supported.





- Single Planning Process and IAP
  - Joint Planning
  - A single Incident Action Plan for all
