



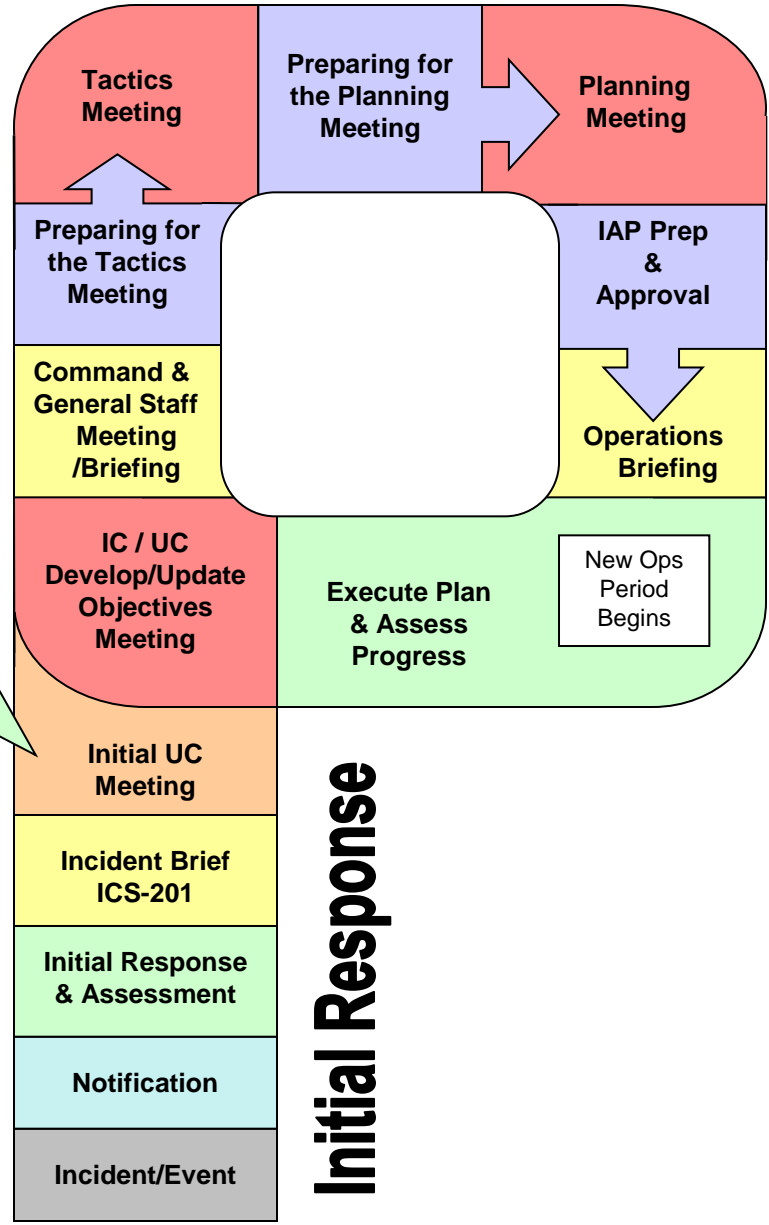

Unified Command

- Meeting of agency representatives with jurisdiction as it relates to the emergency.
- Merging of incident management structures.





Unified Command

- **Single incident organization**
- **Co-located (shared) facility**
- **One Incident Action Plan**
- **Integrated general staff**
- **Coordinated process for resource ordering**



Unified Command

- **Jurisdictions/agencies blend into an integrated, unified team.**
- **Members must function together for this to be effective.**



Unified Command

■ Co-located/Shared Facilities

- Incident commanders need to be together.
- The rest of the organization must function together in a single incident command post so coordination/ collaboration can be supported.





Unified Command

■ Single Planning Process and IAP

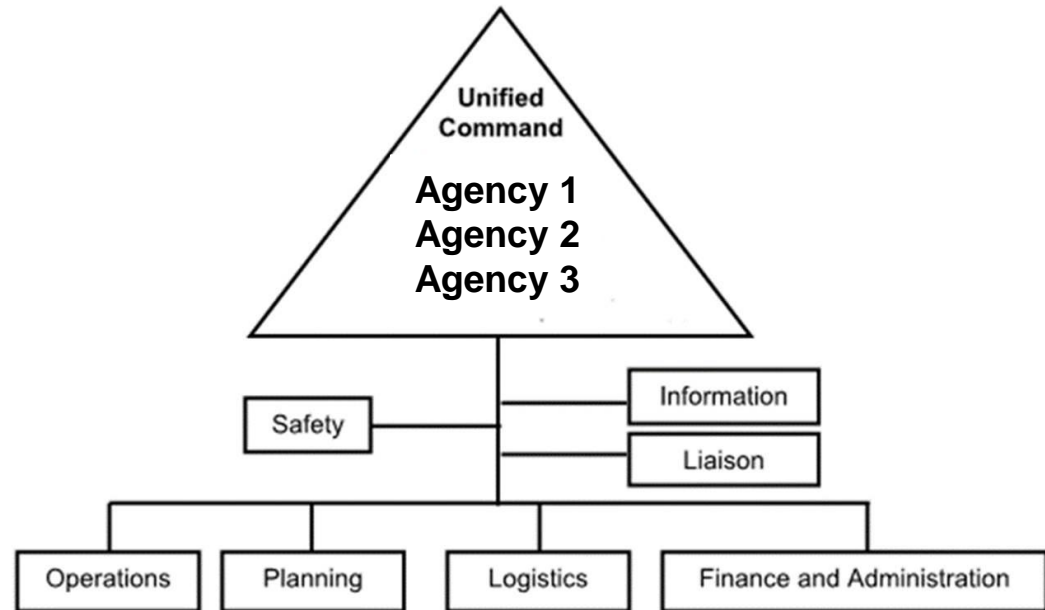
- Joint Planning
- A single Incident Action Plan for all agencies
